Backcountry Permits

- **How to Obtain**: Permits required for overnight stays in the backcountry. Obtain at visitor centers or ranger stations.
- **Reservation System**: Advance reservations available online at Recreation.gov

Transportation

- Scenic Drives: Grand Loop Road connects major sites and attractions.
- **Shuttle Service**: Limited in-park shuttle services; consider guided tours.

Wildlife and Safety

- **Wildlife Viewing**: Bison, elk, bears, wolves, and other wildlife are common. Always maintain a safe distance.
- Bear Safety: Carry bear spray, make noise on trails, and store food properly.
- **Trail Conditions**: Check for updates on trail closures and conditions at visitor centers or the park's website.
