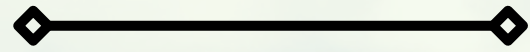




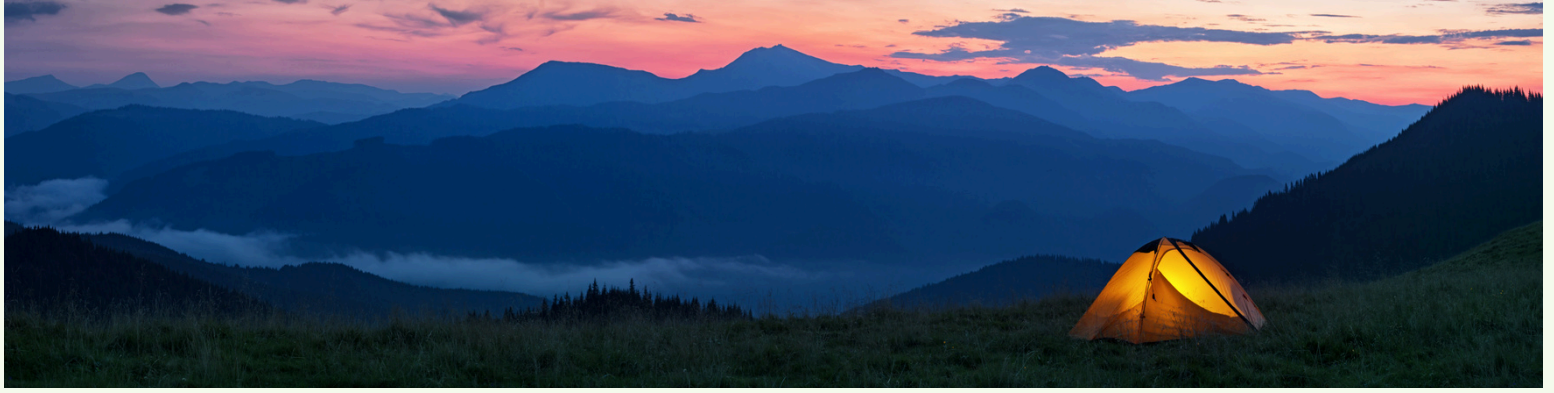

The Essential Camping Checklist

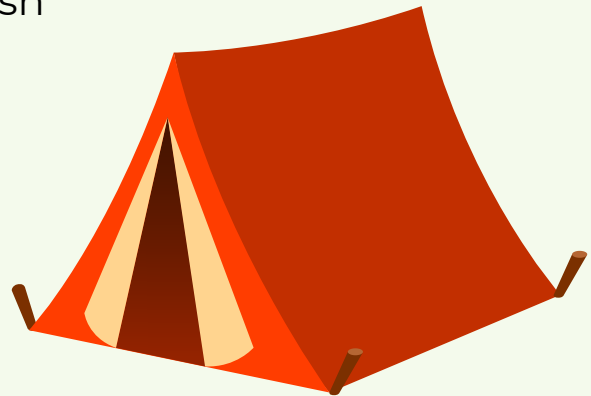

Essential Shelter

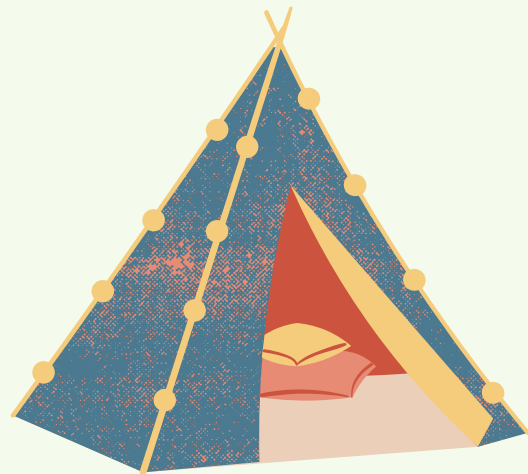
- Tent
- Ground cloth/tarp
- Tent Stakes
- Shade tarp/poles/ropes/stakes
- Good sharp axe
- Mat for entrance to tent/camper
- Dust pan and Counter brush





Bedding

- Sleeping bags rated for the coldest night
- Sheets and Blankets
- Pillows
- Air mattress/sleeping pad/cot
- Pillows
- Air Pump
- Patch kit for the air mattress





Cooking

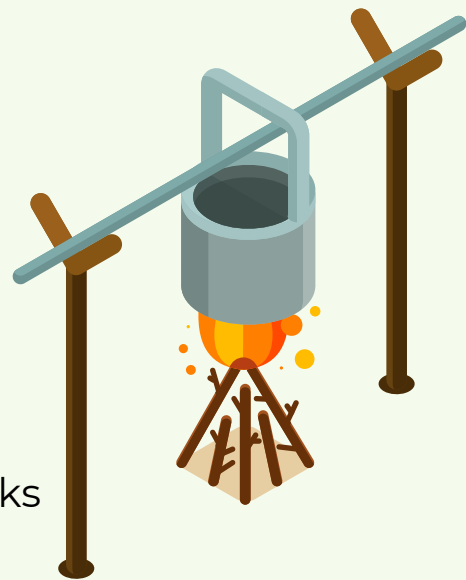
- Large water jug and water bucket
- Trash bags/zip lock bags
- Cooler/ice
- Matches and lighters
- Charcoal/firewood
- Dutch oven and cast iron skillet
- Firestarters/newspaper
- Table cloth/silverware
- Paper towels/napkins
- Paper plates and bowls





Cooking page 2

- Cooking Utensils-Spatula/knife, spoons/tongs
- Camp stove or BBQ grill and folding table.
- Heavy Duty Aluminum foil
- Dish soap and dish pans/dish rags/scrub pads
- Cooking oil/non-stick spray (also can help start fires)
- Measuring cups/spoons
- cutting board/mixing bowls
- Potato peeler
- seasonings/salt and pepper etc
- Pie irons and marshmallow sticks





Clothing

- Weather proof boots and shoes
- Pants/ belts and jeans
- Shorts/t shirts
- Bring lots of socks!!!
- Hats
- Bandana
- sweatshirts/jackets
- Swimsuit and towels

Personal Hygiene

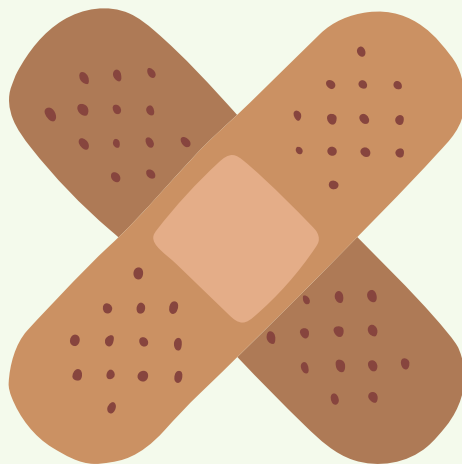
- Shower Shoes/Fipflops

- Combs and hair brush
- Shampoo and body wash





Basic First Aid

- Personal medications
- tylenol or other pain relievers
- Sinus medication
- Neosporin/antibiotic ointment
- tweezers/cotton swabs
- Band-aids/butterfly bandages
- Sterile gauze pads
- clippers/scissors
- Hot and cold packs
- Icy Hot





Basic First Aid

- Sun screen/ sunburn lotion with aloe
- Bug repellent
- After bite stick/ benadryl
- hand sanitizer
- Alcohol
- Peroxide
- Eye drops
- Thermometer
- Antacids
- Chap stick





Miscellaneous

- splitting maul/chainsaw
- citronella candles or tiki torches
- Backpack or fanny pack for hikes
- Camp chairs
- Lanterns
- solar chargers
- Rope/clothesline and clothespins
- propane
- Travel alarm clock
- outdoor games- lasso golf, lawn darts, corn hole
